QUALIFICATIONS—TO BE ELIGIBLE APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a second semester senior or graduate student.
- Be enrolled in a North Carolina college or university in the Charlotte Chapter area. Click here for more information.
- Have a minimum of 18 semester hours in accounting classes, and you may count 1 business law class (3 hours) towards the 18 hour requirement.
Note: The CPA exam requires 30 semester hours in accounting classes in NC.

Prior winners are not eligible.

ACADEMIC MERIT, ACHIEVEMENT, AND ESSAY:

1. Must have evidence of academic achievement, demonstrated by a grade point average (accounting subjects and overall) of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale. Please submit a copy of your transcript along with the application.
2. Must submit a typed essay describing why you chose accounting as your major and how the scholarship would affect your ability to accomplish your academic and career goals. The length for the essay is 500 words. The essay will weigh substantially in the scholarship awarding process. The reviewers (NCACPA members) will consider grammar, punctuation, style, and quality content.

WHAT YOU GET

- Scholarship Amounts: Scholarship amounts will be awarded annually at the discretion of NCACPA's Charlotte Chapter.
- Free Student Membership: All qualified applicants automatically receive a complimentary one-year membership with NCACPA.
