# What Is PKM?

# Personal Knowledge Management ("PKM")

- 1. "Personal knowledge management (PKM) is a collection of processes <u>that a person uses to gather, classify, store, search, retrieve and share knowledge</u> in their daily activities (<u>Grundspenkis 2007</u>) and the way in which these processes support work activities (<u>Wright 2005</u>).
- 2. It is a response to the idea that <u>knowledge</u> workers need to be responsible for their own growth and learning (Smedley 2009).

#### PKM For Career Growth

PKM involves systematically organizing and utilizing knowledge to <u>enhance productivity</u>, continuously <u>develop skills</u>, and <u>achieve</u> <u>professional goals</u>.

- 1. Productivity streamline workflows, reduce effort searching
- **2. Skill development & Learning** tracking/progress to new skills, maintain repository of resources
- 3. Professional networking
- 4. Goal setting and Achievement



#### PKM For Innovation

- PKM fosters creativity and collaboration by <u>efficiently capturing</u>, <u>sharing</u>, <u>and applying insights</u>, enabling individuals and teams to stay ahead of trends and drive new ideas.
- Creativity & Idea Generation capture ideas and brainstorming
- 2. Facilitate Knowledge Sharing share insights, build collaborative environment
- 3. Monitor Trends & Research curate a knowledge base
- Robust Search & Retrieval instant retrieval of critical information

#### 1 - Awareness

**Awareness** is about creating a process to stay informed and understand what is happening around you, ensuring that the knowledge and information you accumulate are relevant and aligned with your goals and tasks.



# 2 - Security

**Security** ensures that your personal knowledge assets are protected from unauthorized access, breaches, and potential data loss, while also including a robust password management process for quick and secure access to your information.



# 3 - Digital

**Digital** emphasizes the integration and utilization of digital tools and platforms to manage, store, and retrieve knowledge efficiently. This approach fosters a paperless environment, leveraging technology to enhance the organization, accessibility, and sharing of information.



# 4 - Accessibility (Mobile)

**Accessibility**, particularly on mobile, emphasizes the importance of having seamless access to your knowledge and information across devices, anytime and anywhere.



#### 5 - Cloud

**Cloud**-based PKM leverages online storage and services to manage, sync, and access knowledge and information across multiple platforms and devices.



#### 6 - Automation

**Automation** in PKM refers to using tools and processes to streamline the collection, organization, retrieval, and sharing of knowledge, reducing manual effort and increasing efficiency.



#### 7 - Generative Al

**Gen AI** in PKM incorporates generative artificial intelligence to enhance the discovery, creation, and management of knowledge, offering advanced insights and automated assistance.



#### 8 – Search

**Search** pertains to the capability to quickly and effectively locate specific knowledge and information within your personal knowledge repository using advanced search tools and techniques.

# Why a Framework is Crucial for PKM

- 1. Organization ensures that knowledge is systematically categorized
- Efficiency a consistent approach allows you to streamline your PKM processes
- 3. Consistency enhances reliability and reduces errors
- **4. Scalability -** a framework allows you to scale your PKM efforts without losing control over the information
- **5.** Review and Improvement continuous improvement leads to more effective knowledge management

## **DEMO** - Custom GPTs – PDF Document Analyzer




- GPTs are basically ChatGPT "apps"
